## **Elementary School / Middle School**

- -Introduce Transition Planning
- Introduce and Register students in intensive needs classes to New York State, Office for People with Developmental Disabilities.
- -Determine OPWDD Eligibility

(Student can receive provisional eligibility at age 4 and permanent eligibility at age 8)

- -Complete OPWDD Front Door Process (Informational Session & Assessment)
- -Begin Accessing services (Non-Medicaid Service Coordination, Home Health Care Management, Waiver Services, Self Determination) etc.
- 7th & 8th graders complete Level 1 Vocational Assessments annually.
