Dear Parents/Guardians of Eighth-Grade Students:

On **Wednesday, May 10, 2023**, the entire eighth-grade class will be going to New York City to see *HAMILTON* at the Richard Rogers Theatre, located at 226 West 46th Street. In addition, we will be having lunch at Dave & Buster's, located at 234 West 42nd Street.

Since the production of *HAMILTON* is a matinee starting at 2:00 p.m., we will be eating lunch at Dave & Buster's before the show. We will be taking coach buses into Manhattan and leaving South Middle School at approximately 9:45 a.m., returning to **South High School** at approximately 6:00 p.m. Parents are asked to pick their children up promptly at that time. Children will be allowed to call their parents from the bus so as to alert them to the proper pick-up time.

The price of **\$305 per child** includes the show, lunch, a Power Card for games at Dave & Buster's, and the coach bus transportation. The lunch buffet consists of chicken fingers, sliders, pizza bites, salad, mac and cheese, and french fries. In addition, students will receive unlimited fountain sodas and a cookie. The permission slip and a check made out to **Great Neck Public Schools** are due no later than **Friday, March 31st**. Please remember to write your child's name on the memo line. Please return the items in a sealed envelope, and give the envelope to your child's homeroom teacher. Please note that refunds cannot be given if, for some reason, your child is unable to attend.

Please note: Parents who wish to donate extra money to help defray the cost of the trip for families who are struggling financially are welcome to do so. Scholarship funds are available.
